**Date of Festival:** October 10, 2009

**Deadline:** September 10, 2009. Mail Teacher Registration Form to LINDA BANFY

**Festival Center:** Texas Christian University, Ed Landreth Hall

**Eligibility:** Any music student (piano, voice or other instrument) studying in the metroplex, grades K through 12. Student may participate in one or both Festivals.

**Entry Fee:** One Festival \$10.00. Two Festivals \$15.00 (No Refunds)

Each piece played has a four-minute time limit. A minimum of five entries (collectively from all teachers) will be required for instruments other than piano. Please call one of the Chairmen for clarification or other questions.

**Awards:** All students receive a rating, critique sheet and a participation ribbon. Those receiving a superior rating receive an additional "superior" ribbon. Awards are given immediately after adjudication.

**Repertoire:** Solo literature or duet (one piano-two students) literature is acceptable. No transcriptions or photocopied music will be allowed. All pieces must be completely memorized.

**JAZZ:** pieces in a jazz style including boogie, blues, ragtime, Dixieland and improvisation.

**BAROQUE pieces** are those composed in the musical era of 1600-1750.

**Critique Sheets:** Festival critique forms are included with your handbook. There must be one completed sheet for each piece to be performed. Photocopy as many forms as needed from this one form. Please be accurate in completing the information. Each student must bring one completed critique sheet for each piece played. Students must bring original copies of the music of pieces to be played, with measures numbered.

**Playing Times:** Teachers will be notified by letter, each student's specific assigned time to play and the room location. Teachers are responsible for transmitting this information to students. Please indicate on the teacher registration form if there is a specific time needed for a student. There can be no changes once times are assigned. Students must report to assigned room at the assigned time.

Mail Teacher Registration Form and one check covering all entries to LINDA BANFY. Make checks payable to FWMTA. No entry postmarked after September 10, 2009 will be accepted.
