1. Based on our 2010-2011 Student Affiliate Enrollment, Fort Worth Association will be allowed two local winners in each category of the Performance Contests. Please see the **list of categories** in the Student Affiliate Handbook.
2. Official application/repertoire forms are on the TMTA Website. Open that file, **type in the data and print out** – keeping a second copy for your files.
3. Please send one check for all applications, payable to FWMTA with the filled out application form.
4. A photocopy of the first page of each composition to be performed must be included. Please make sure this clearly shows the Title, Composer, Opus numbers or section names.
5. The State fees listed on the Application form will be collected from the winners following the Local Contest. All local winning pianists, vocalists, instrumentalists and Young Artists will advance directly to the State Contest.
6. These Contests are open to students in Grades 7 – 12 and Young Artists entrants who are High School graduates and will not be over age 27 on date of State Contest. See SA Handbook for details of the State Contests.
7. Contestants are students of a Student Affiliate Teacher or a non member teacher who may enter students in this contest for an extra fee. Contact local SA Chair for information.
8. Except for Young Artists, contestants must pass the State level Theory Test.
9. The same repertoire must be performed at all levels of the Competition.
10. Students may enter more than one category of the contest as long as each category involves a different instrument.
11. Contestants must bring copies of their printed music to the Contest. No photocopies.
12. First place winners in last year's State Contest are not eligible to enter the same category Contest again.

ALL TEACHERS WHO ENTER STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ASSIST IN RUNNING THE CONTEST.

The format of the Texas Music Teachers Association STUDENT AFFILIATE Performance is described in the TMTA Student Affiliate Handbook. Teachers who wish to participate in this program should study it carefully. All applications are to be typed on the form on the TMTA website.
