ENROLLMENT and FEES

1. Participating teachers must be active members of the Fort Worth Music Teachers Association with dues paid in full.
2. Teachers may enroll any number of students in school grades one through twelve and post-12th.
3. Each returning teacher will be sent an official state form electronically for re-enrolling students. Instructions will be included with this list. Check it carefully for accuracy in spelling of names and grade levels. Make a copy of the form for your files. If this is your first time to enroll SA students, request a blank form from the Chairman. Students are enrolled according to school grade level. In the case of home-schooled students or pilot-school programs, teachers must declare an enrollment grade level at the time of registration. Any change of student grade level within the year must be reported to the local SA chairman and the TMTA Office.
4. **DUES. Student Dues are \$13.00 per student if paid by September 16, 2011.**

Teacher Participation Fee is \$12.00 due with student enrollment lists.

Make checks out to FWMTA!!!

Send your student list with check to cover each student fee, plus the one time teacher fee, to JOSE ANTONIO CUBELA by **September 16!** Chairman asks that you meet this deadline!! ALL Association lists must be sent at the same time to the State office by the Chairman's deadline of October 1, 2011.

If you miss the deadline you may enroll students in one of these late enrollment dates:

Late Enrollment Deadline I - November 21, 2011. Student fee increases to \$14.00 per student.

This date is required for enrolling students in Spring Theory Testing:

Late Enrollment Deadline II - January 9, 2012. Student fee increases to \$14.00 per student.

5. The description and information about FWMTA sponsored SA activities are found in this yearbook. Registration forms for some events are available. Some registration forms must be requested from the Chairman of the activity.

STATE LEVEL ACTIVITIES

1. Students participating in the SA Performance Contest, High School Ensemble Teams, Texas-American Composer Ensemble teams, Original Composition Contest or Chamber Music Contest must score 70 or more on a theory exam graded at the state level.

2. Student Affiliate activities are a part of the Texas Music Teachers Convention, held every June. Students selected to represent Fort Worth in any of these State activities are expected to attend the Convention.

3. Details of state-level Student Affiliate activities are in the Student Affiliate Handbook which every teacher receives in the mail and may be viewed on www.tmta.org website.

YOUNG ARTIST (Post 12th) ENROLLMENTS

1. A student post-12th grade to age 27 may be a MTA member. Please follow this procedure:

a. Obtain an MTNA New Membership Application from the Membership Chairman of the Association or online from mtna.org. Fill it out and include dues with it. Last year's post-12th grade members receive dues payment notices from the National office. Include that form with dues.

b. Make checks payable to MTNA, a total \$12.00 per student.

2. Post-12th grade students will receive the *American Music Teacher* and *Texas Music Teacher* magazines and will be official members of MTNA and FWMTA.
